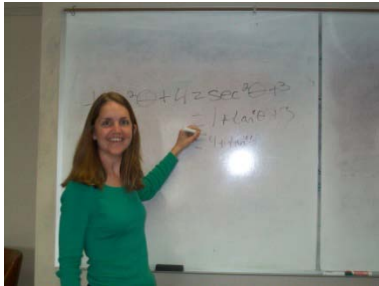

events, prom, year book, The Vision, and of course

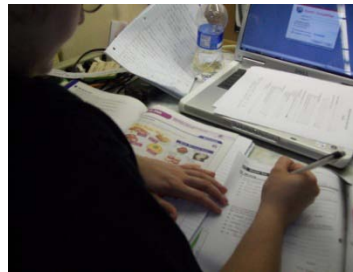
MSMS's own literature magazine, Southern Voices.
