

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Be a resident of Mississippi.
- Be a current tenth grader with a minimum of 12 Carnegie units of study upon completion of tenth grade. Students must earn a minimum of 13 units while at MSMS.
- Have a record of school performance that is above average (B or higher) in most subjects and superior (A) in mathematics and science. While MSMS does focus on mathematics and science, we also offer a wide variety of classes in the arts and humanities to ensure that students benefit from a well-rounded curriculum.
- Have a strong desire to attend MSMS. Students attending MSMS must be self-motivated to meet the academic requirements and succeed in the residential setting.
- Be noted for intellectual curiosity, analytical thinking, and imagination.
- Have earned high scores on the ACT (standardized test). Your application will not be reviewed unless you have submitted an ACT score.
- Submit a completed application.

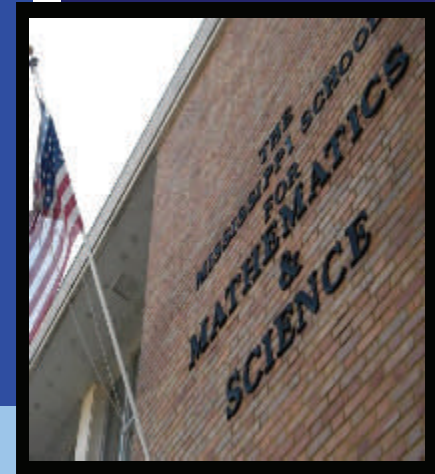
