PARENTS: In each section below, choose the best option regarding the extent to which your child may use his/her vehicle while at school. This school reserves the right to restrict use of the vehicle beyond the limits established on this form and may consult with the parent should this be necessary. The school will not extend or expand permission beyond what the parent approves herein. Changes may be made any time during the school year by notifying the Director for Student Affairs in writing.

SECTION I: KEYS. (*select one of the following*)

- Keys to the vehicle may be kept by the student. (Juniors are required to check keys in at their residence hall office until interim grades are issued).
- Keys to the vehicle must be given to the residence hall staff and returned to student according to the permissions granted on this form.

SECTION II: USE OF VEHICLE. (*select one of the following*)

- May use the vehicle only for trips home.
- May use the vehicle for trips home, and within Lowndes County.

NOTE: No student will be allowed to travel beyond Lowndes County without specific school permission for each occurrence, except when traveling home. Parental permission for each occurrence will be necessary for trips beyond Lowndes County, except when traveling home and when traveling to a destination already approved by inclusion on the overnight form. No student will be allowed to use their vehicle if the school deems travel/weather conditions unsafe.
